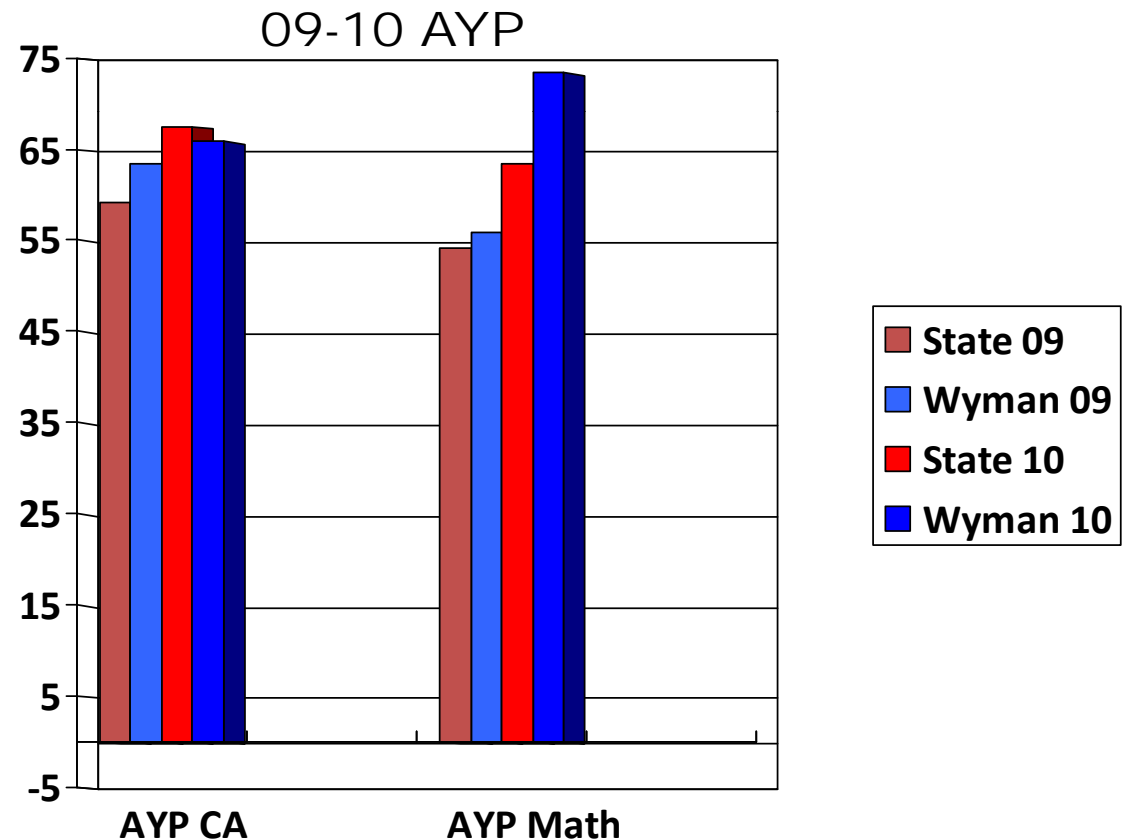

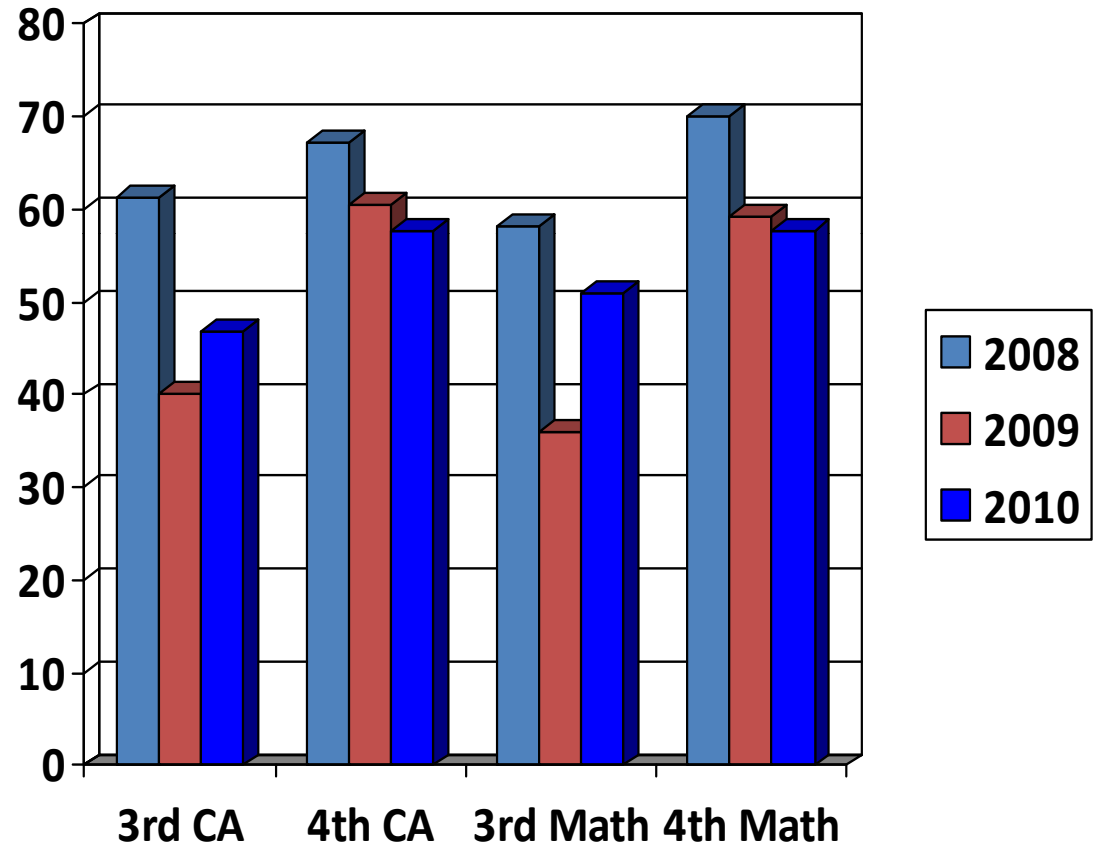

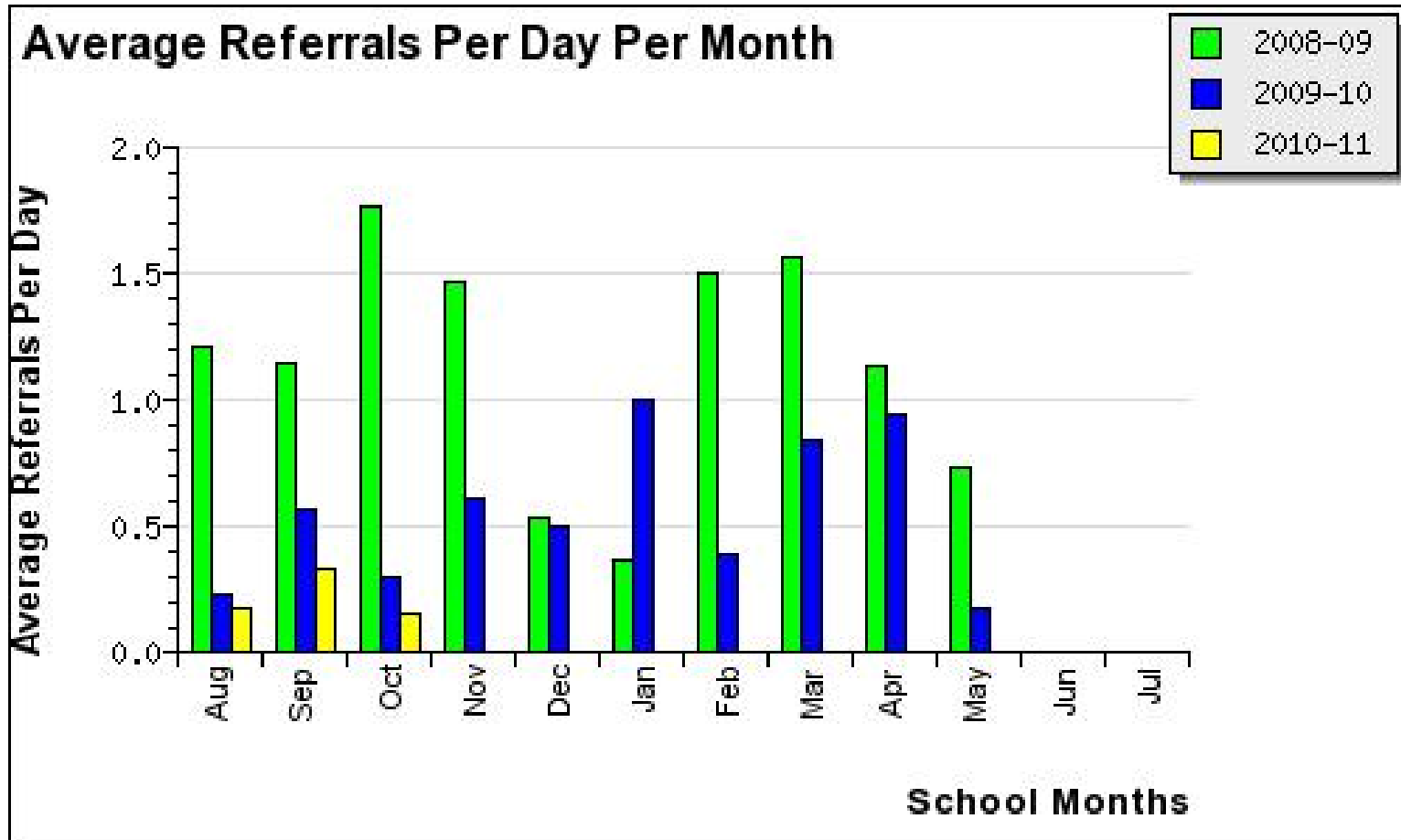
MAP Grade Level Differences
